The purpose of this Bulletin is to notify all insurers providing health insurance coverage in Delaware that Senate Bill No. 316, as amended by Senate Amendment No. 1, of the 151st General Assembly ("SB 316"), signed by the Governor on October 26, 2022, added new sections 3344D and 3560C to the Delaware Insurance Code (18 **Del.C.** §§ 101, et seq.) and applies to policies, contracts, or certificates issued, renewed, modified, altered, amended, or reissued on or after January 1, 2024. Both new sections limit the amount that an individual policy or group plan may charge for diabetes equipment and supplies, other than insulin, at no more than \$35 per month for each enrolled individual. The \$35 per month cap includes the deductible payments and cost-sharing amounts once a deductible is met. The \$35 cap does not apply to deductible payments charged by high deductible health plans or catastrophic health plans.
